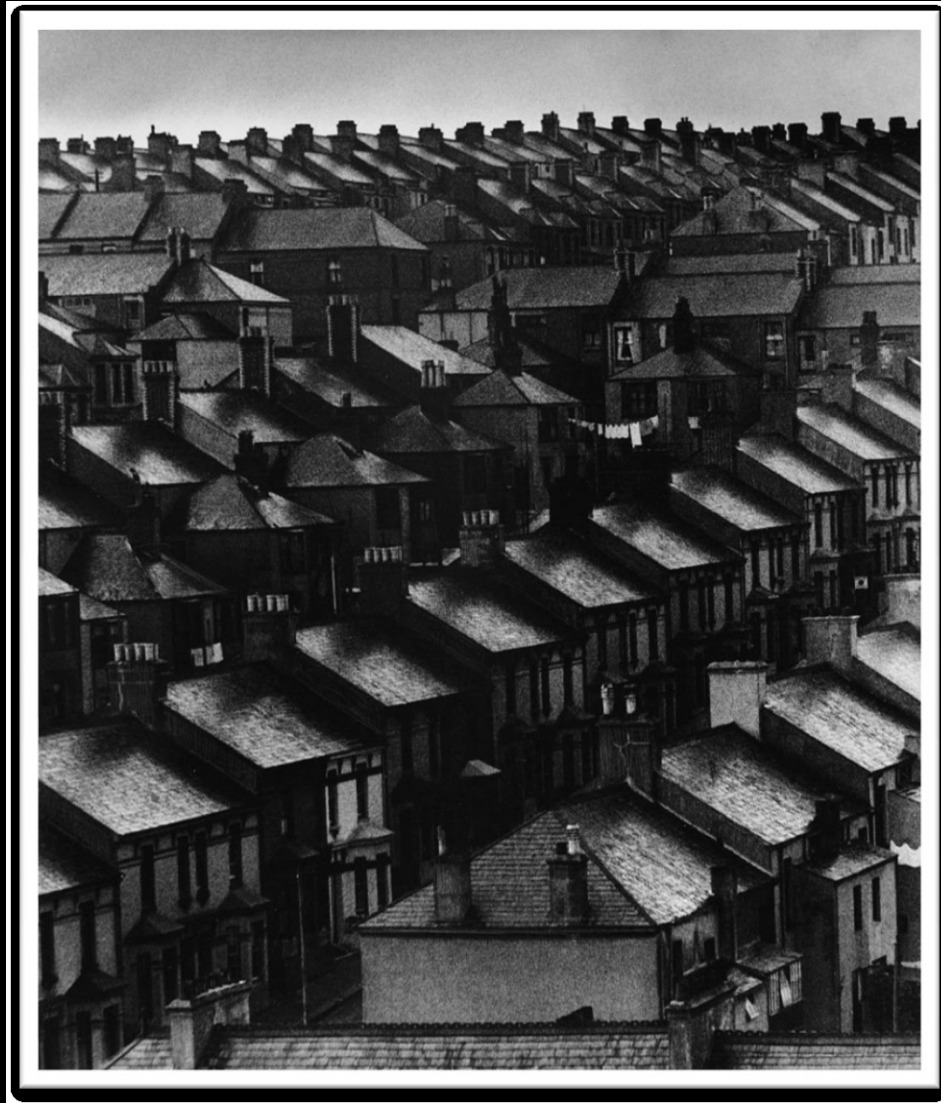
Bill Brandt

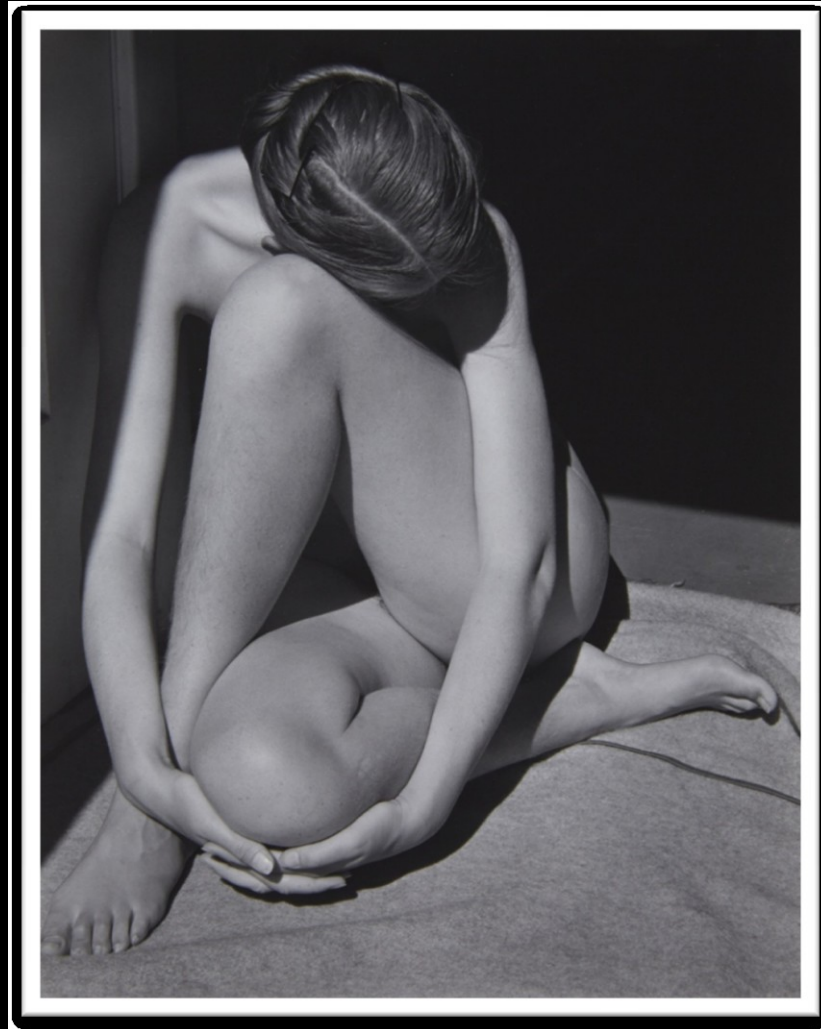


Edward Weston

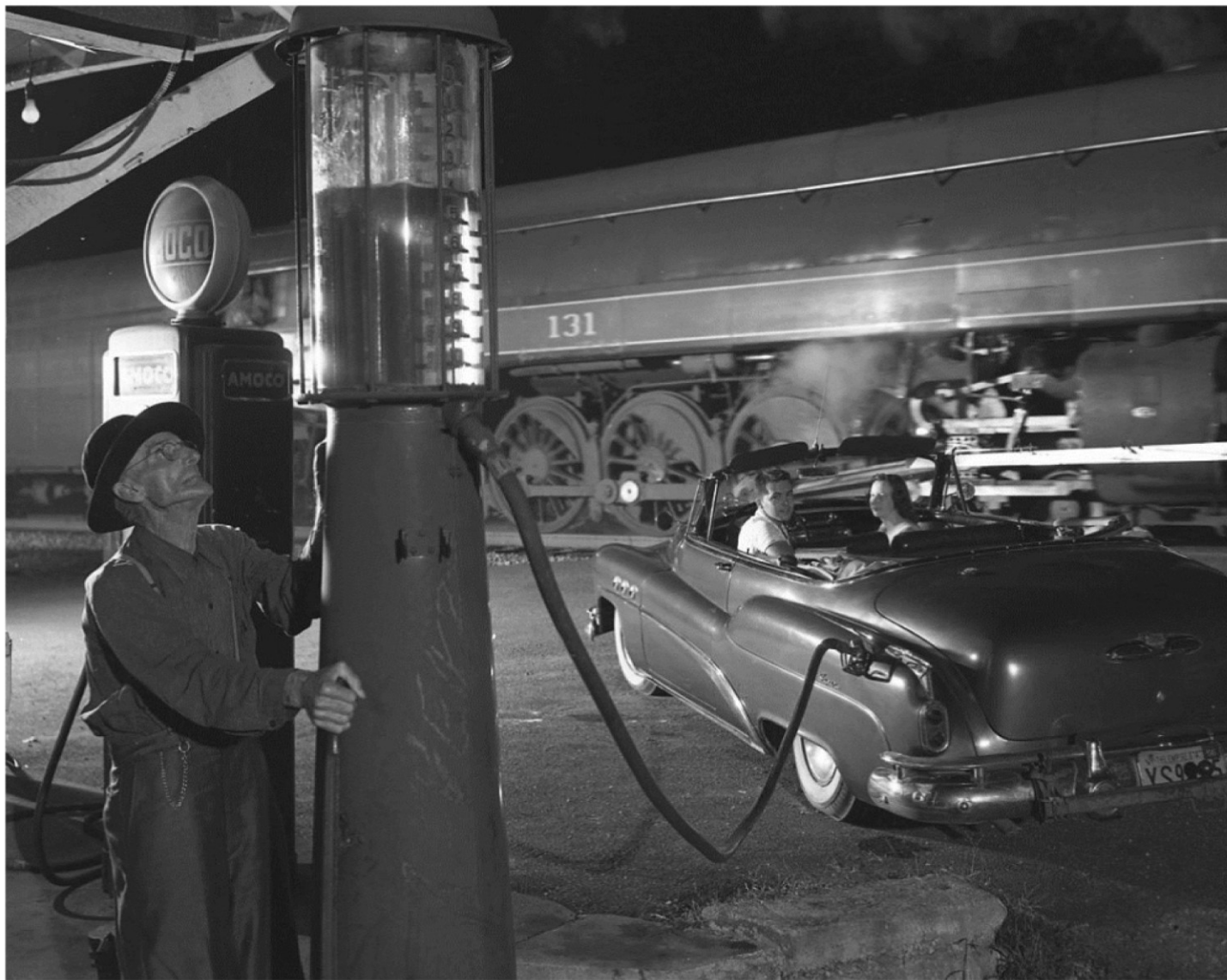
O. Winston Link

- 1914 - 2001

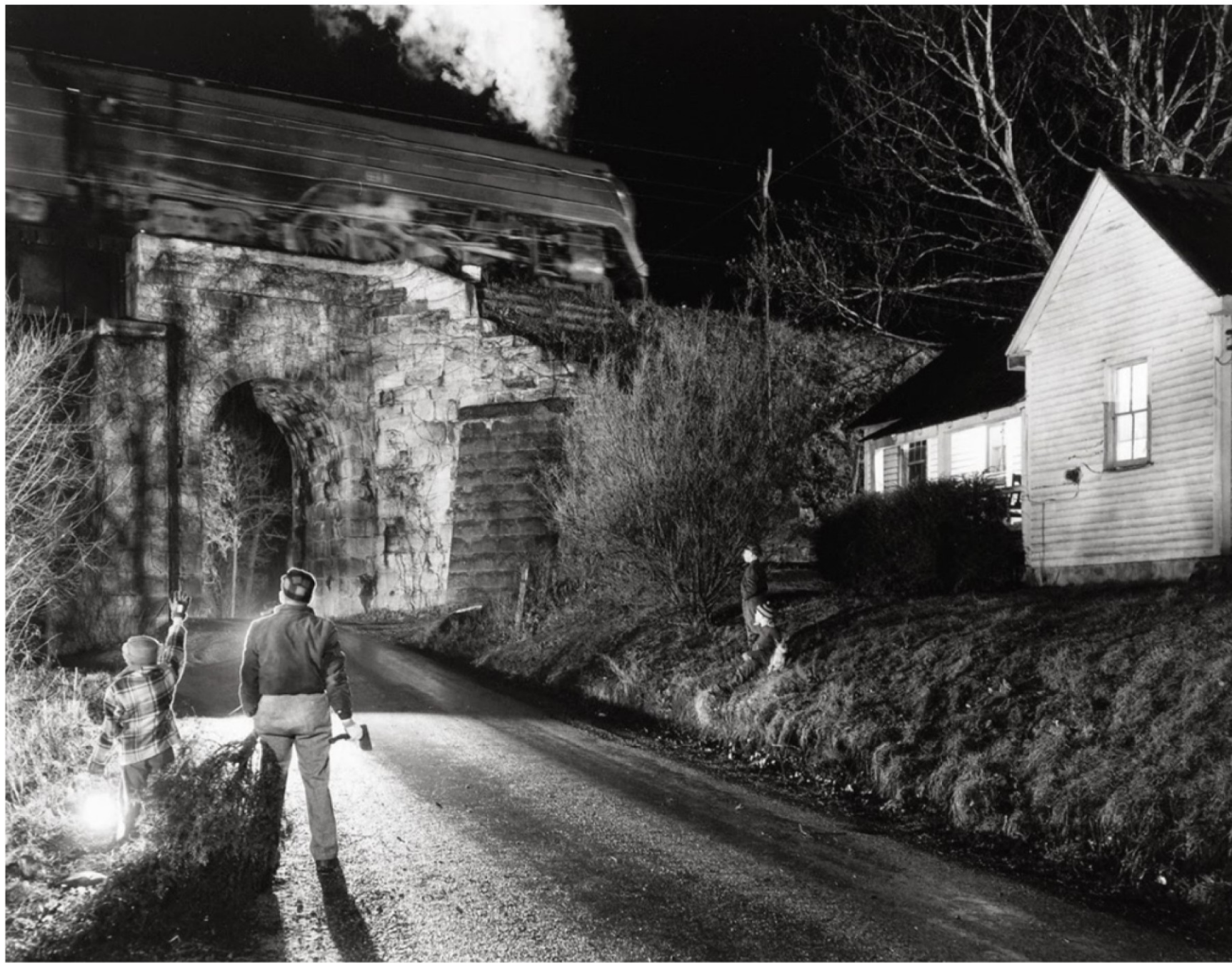
Main Line on Main Street, North Fork, West Virginia, 1958

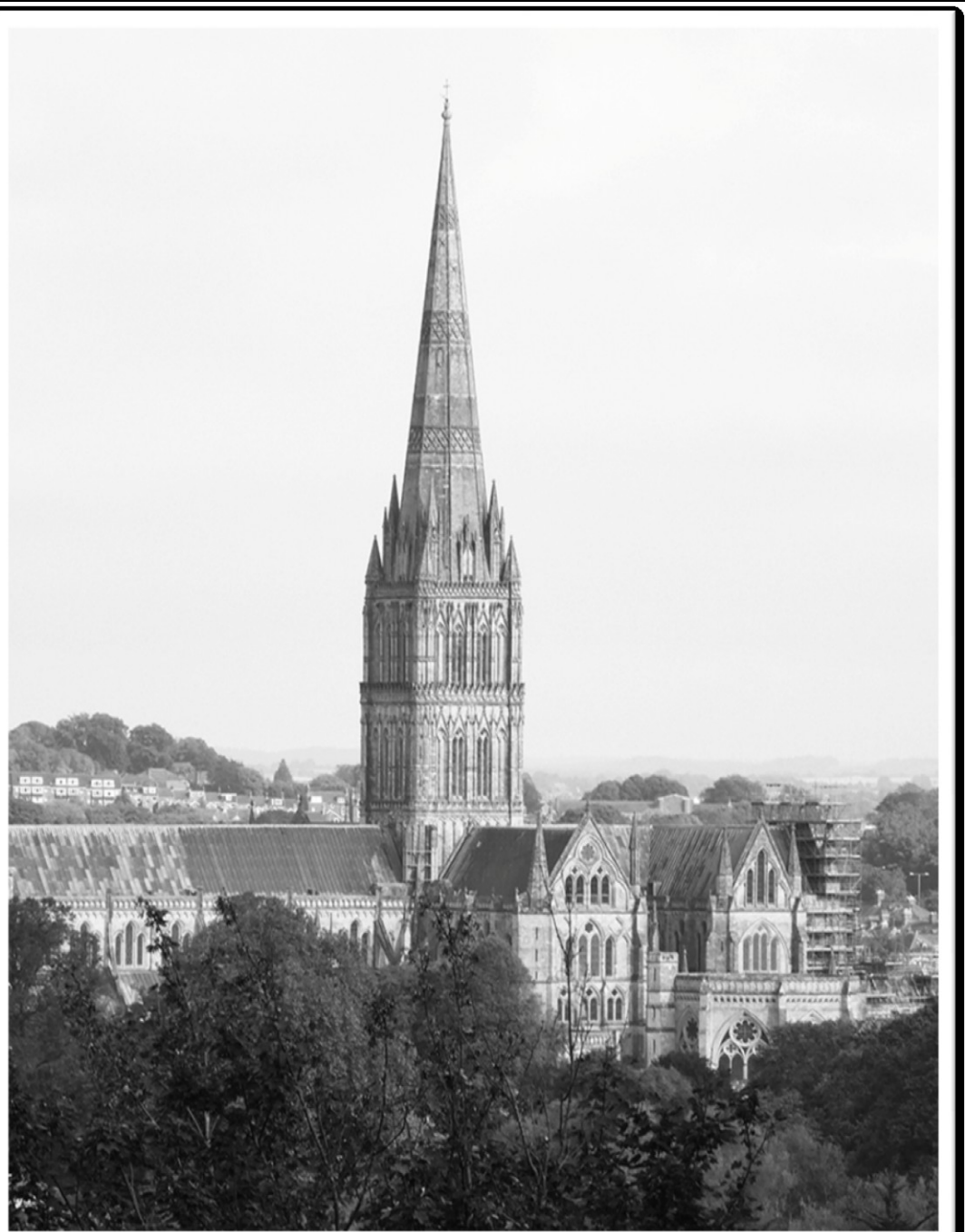

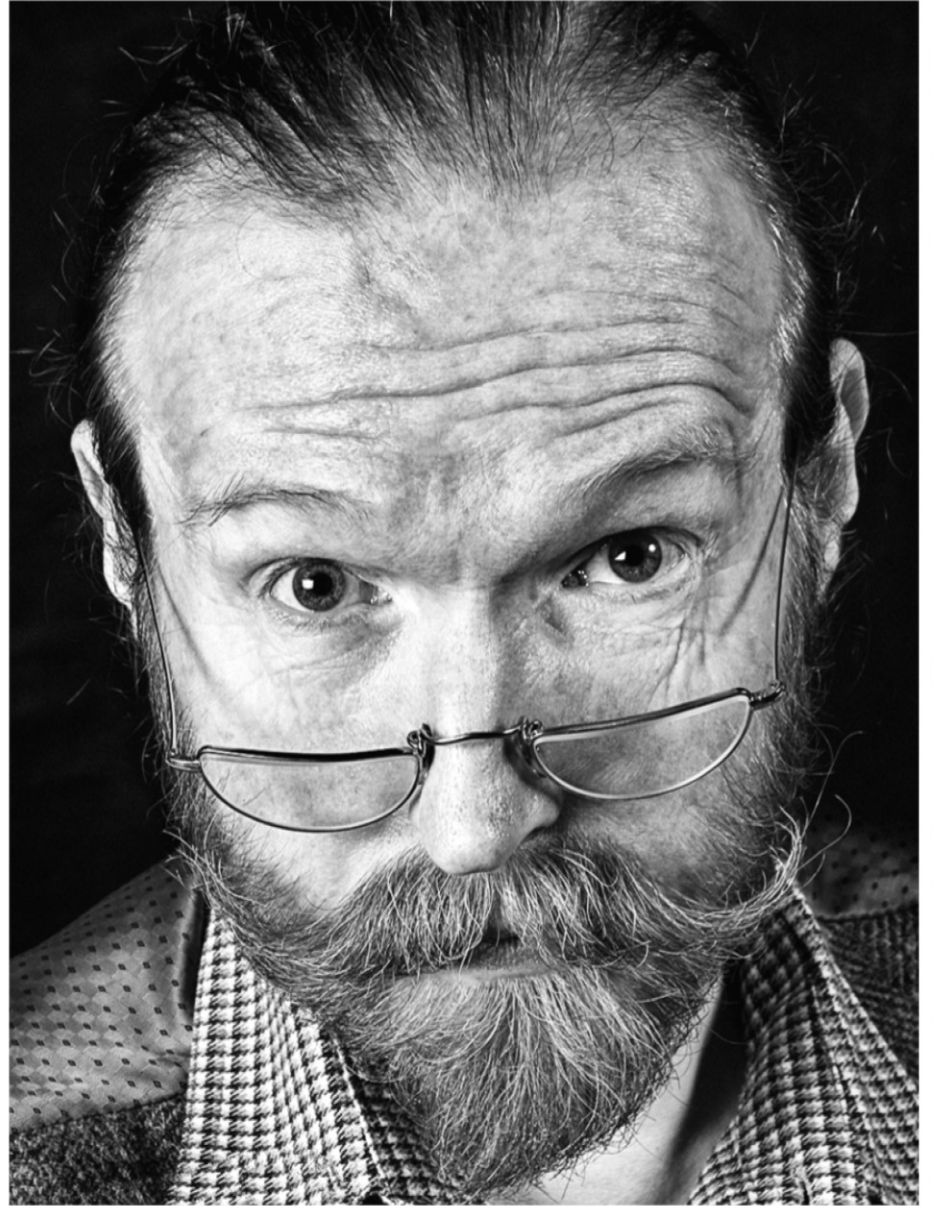

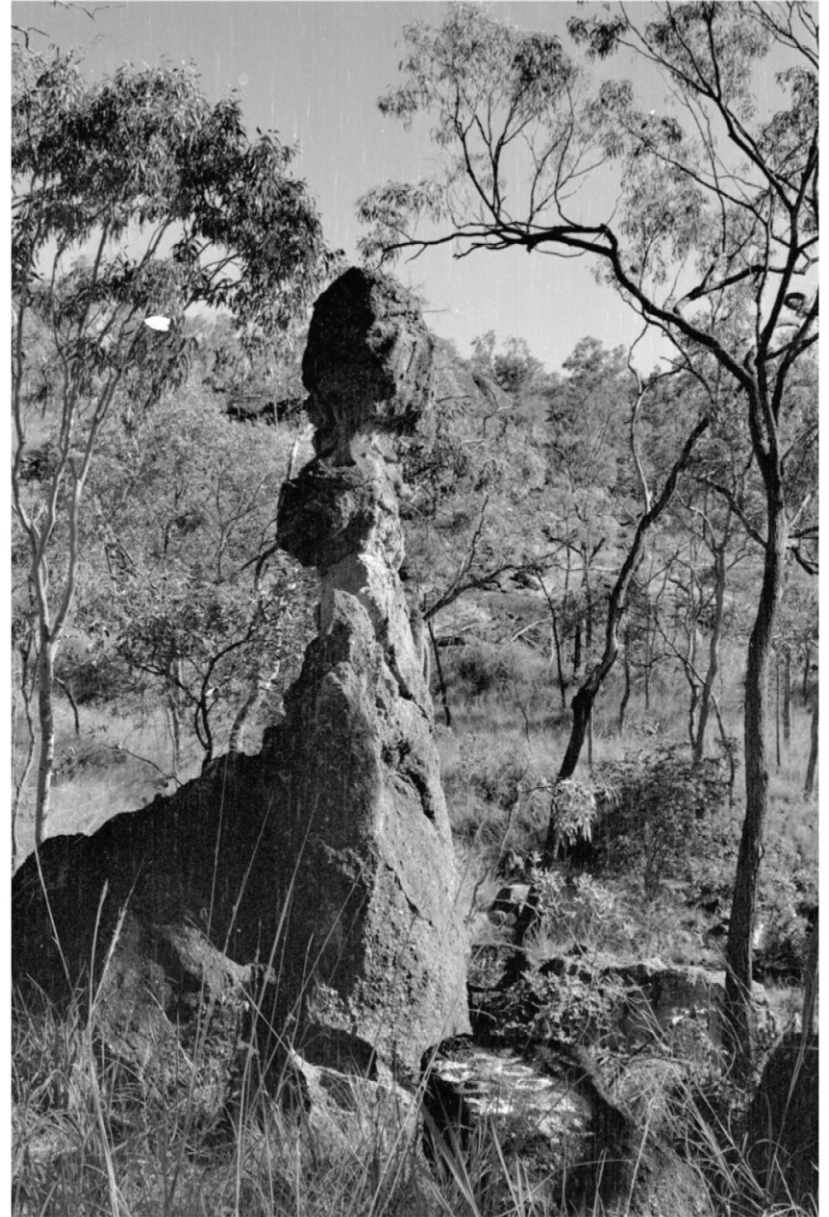

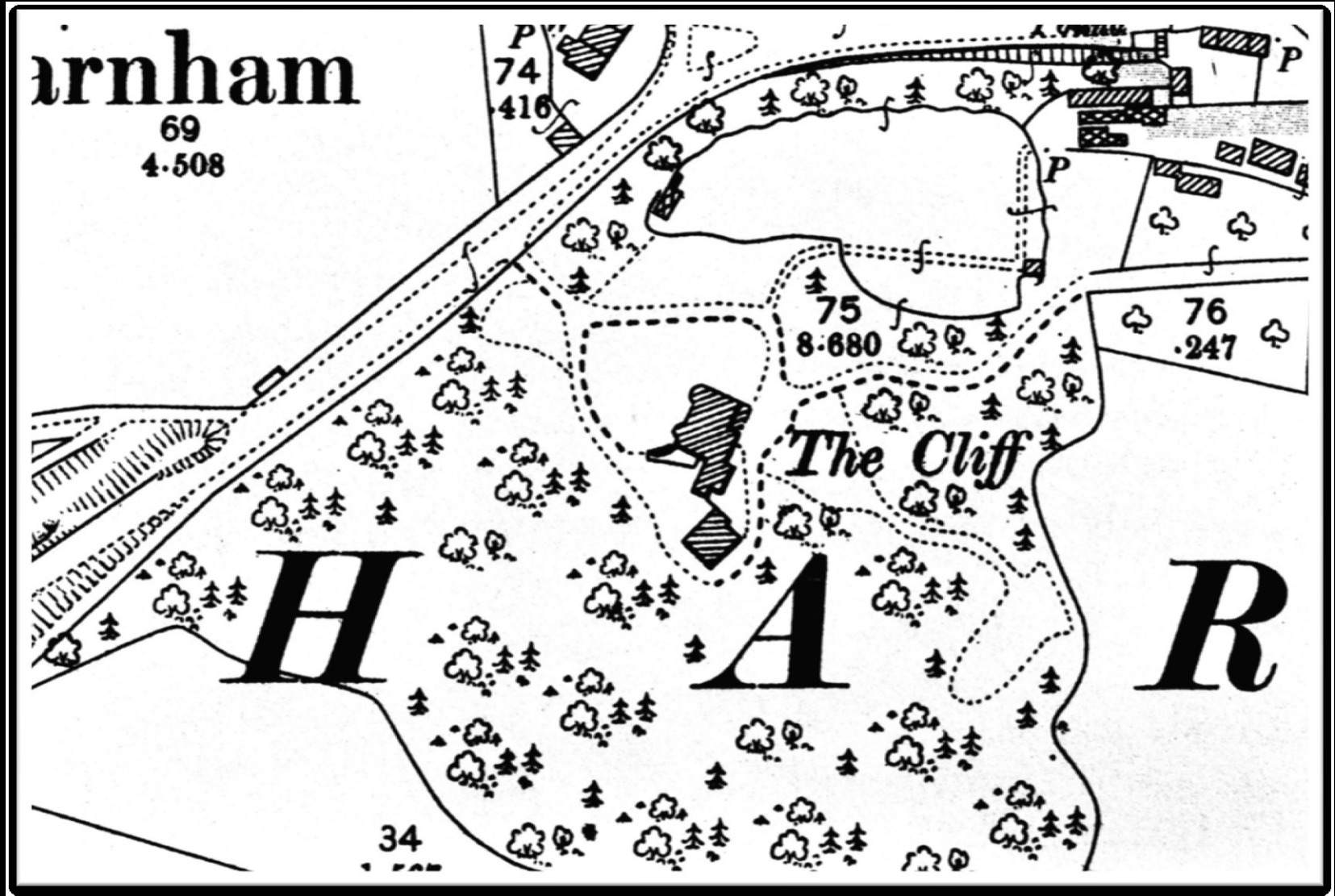
